### Responsibilities of the AmeriCorps position include but are not limited to:

- Participate in the Outreach and Communications Committee (assist in developing materials and presentations including press releases, displays, public service announcements, flyers) to reach organizations that partner with KCHC and the underserved targeted population
- Participate in Health Fairs, Community events, Awareness initiatives in Kenosha County and the surrounding communities to promote KCHC Services, including medical, dental, behavior health, and KCHC's new mobile medical unit. Educate the community on insurance access and chronic disease management and prevention, and how to connect to KCHC for services, and support Open Enrollment Events
- Help plan National Health Center Week, KCHC's sponsored Health Fairs, FluFIT Clinic, CRC Awareness month, and more.
- Participate in Non-Profit Networking Groups and Events to make connects with other community organizations.
- Support KCHC's literacy program: Reach Out Read, by securing book donations, identifying and promoting community literacy resources, and developing a volunteer reader program.
- Promote KCHC's Patient Portal and support patients with the registration process.
